## Introduction:

MSFC Ireland is an intercollegiate assembly of medical students and we strongly support the explicit inclusion of the promotion of **sexual and reproductive health and rights** with the revision of the White Paper.

## Key Issues & Ways of Working:

**Sexual and reproductive health and rights** are a fundamental component of global health, as reflected by the Millennium Development Goal 5: the improvement of maternal health by reducing maternal mortality and achieving universal access to reproductive health.

The current White Paper's identifies challenges in international human rights and gender equality. This area **must** be expanded to explicitly include:

- Funding NGOs involved with sexual and reproductive health and rights
- · Reporting of Irish Aid outputs relating to sexual and reproductive health and rights
